MOVIE NIGHT

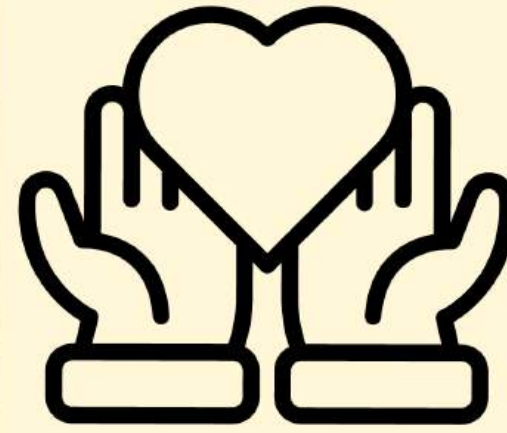
Key Stage 1 and reception children had a great time at their Mini Movie Night – we watched short films, ate a hot dog and left school with a bag of sweets – what a treat!

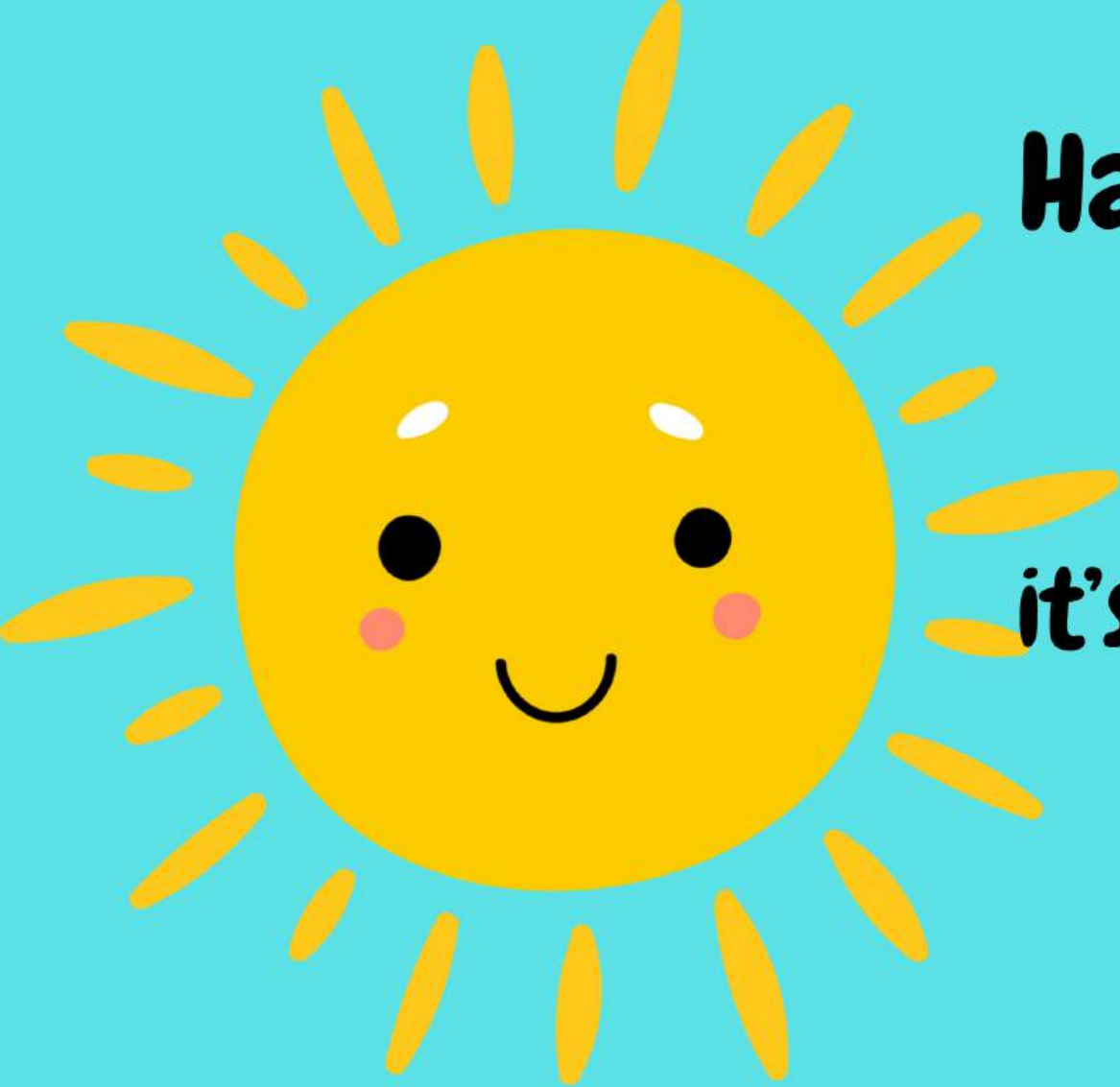

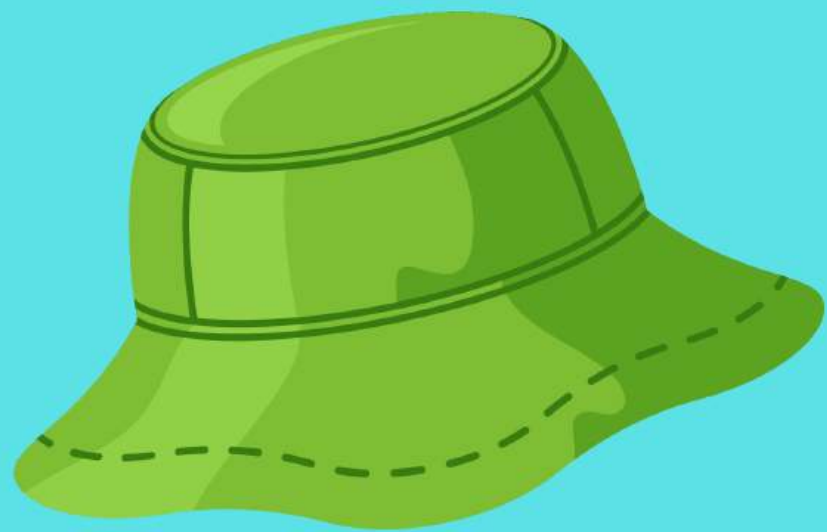

The best entry from each age category will win a prize – and even better, the winning poster will be displayed at some of our properties to help spread your message!

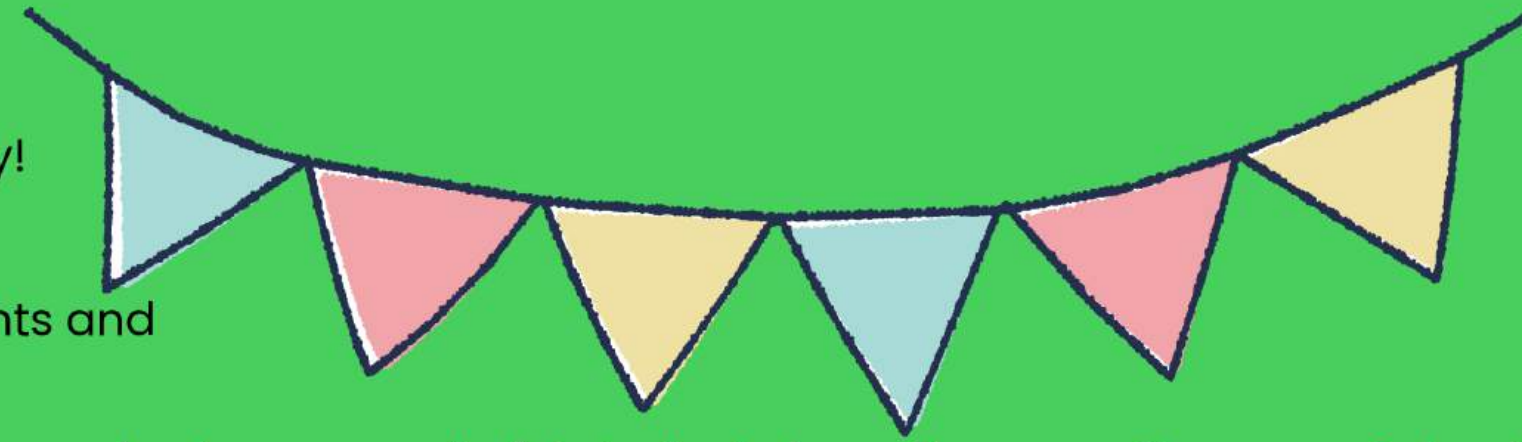
