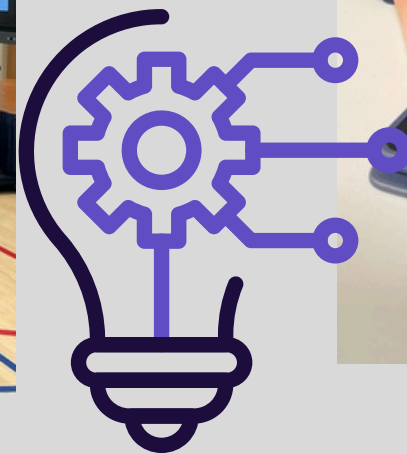

IPAD UNBOXING!



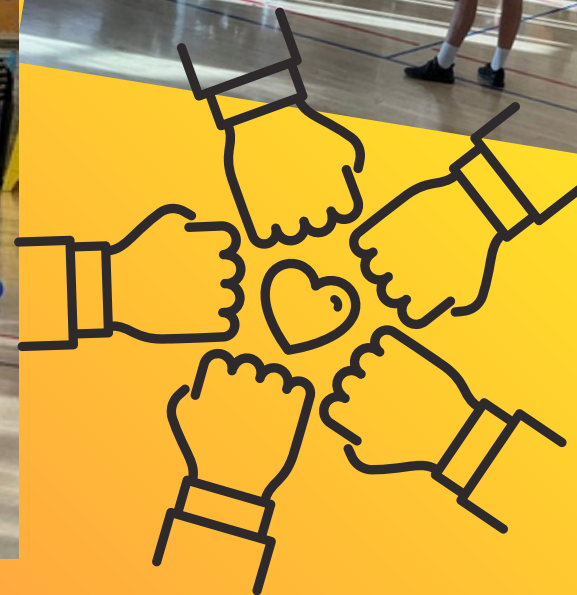

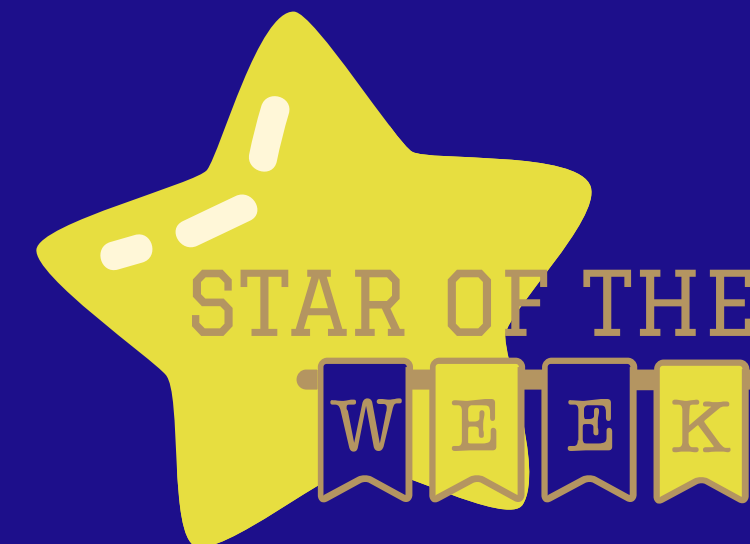
