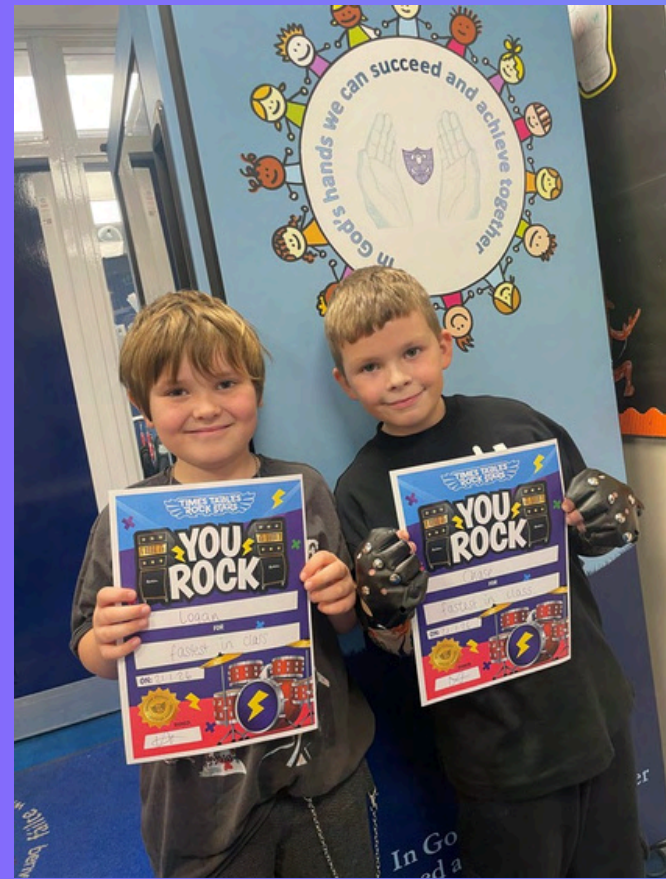
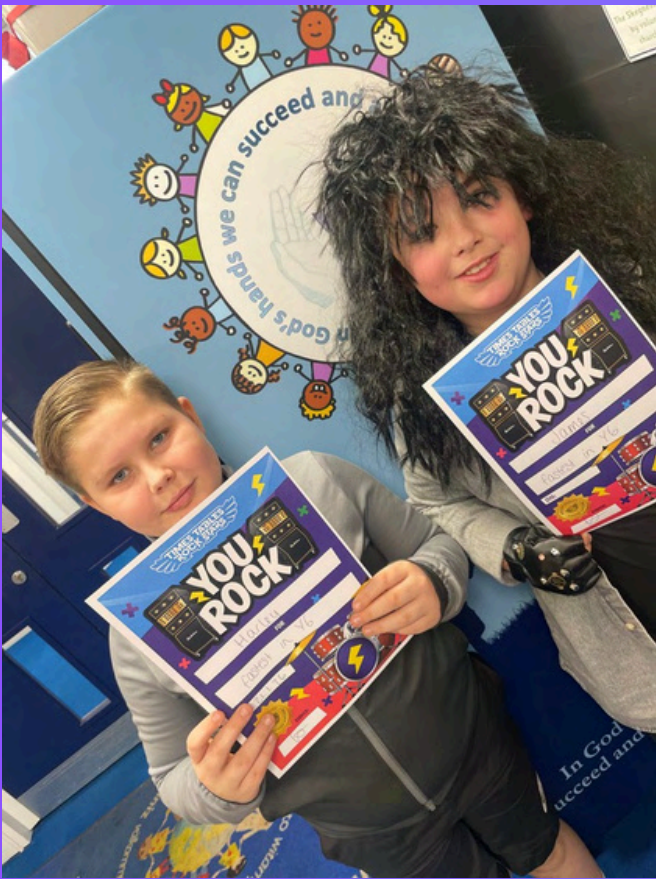
Thank you to families for your continued support. Together, we are building a caring community where children are encouraged to learn, grow and flourish.



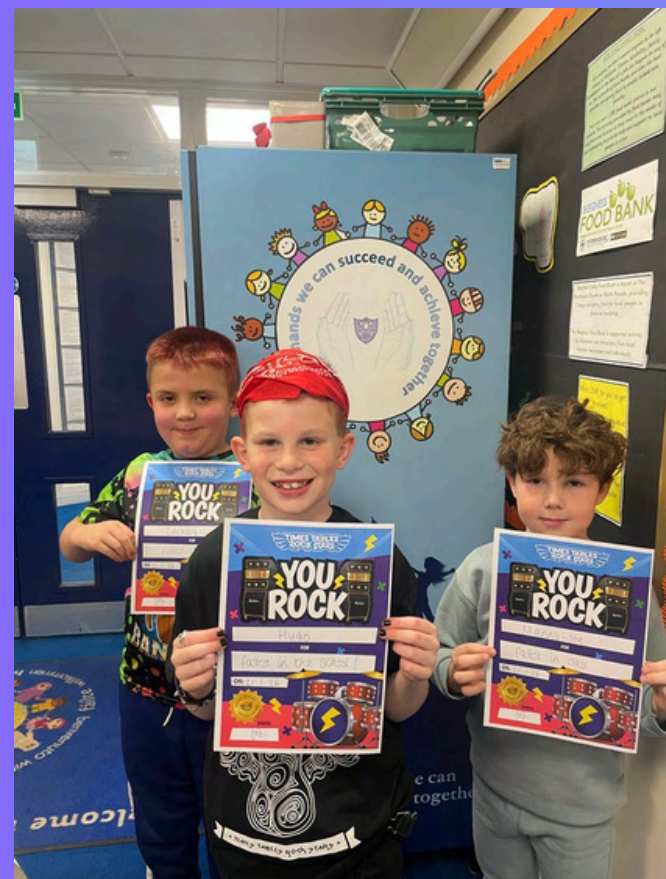
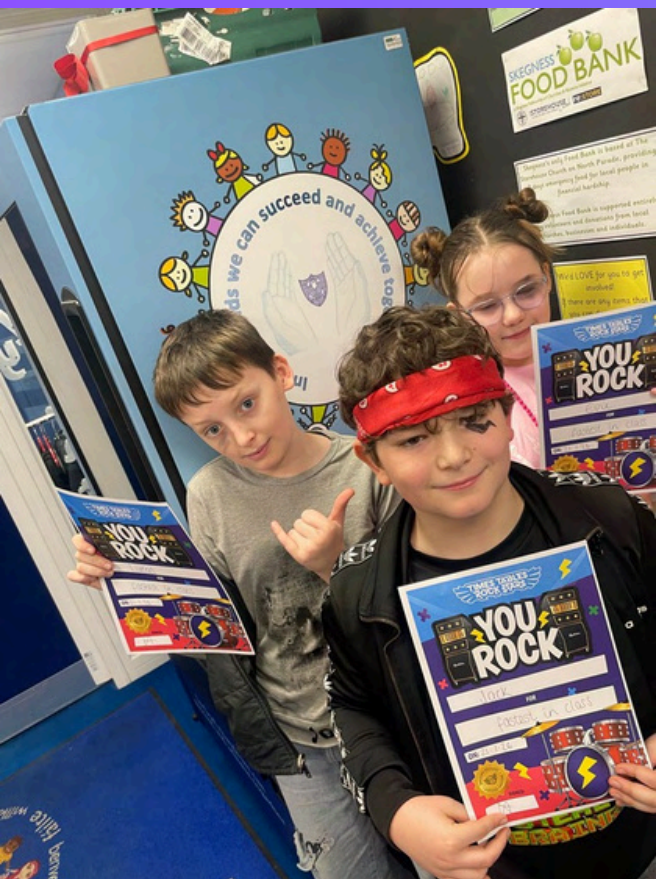
TIMES TABLES ROCKSTARS DAY
