# Year 3 visit Yorkshire Wildlife Park

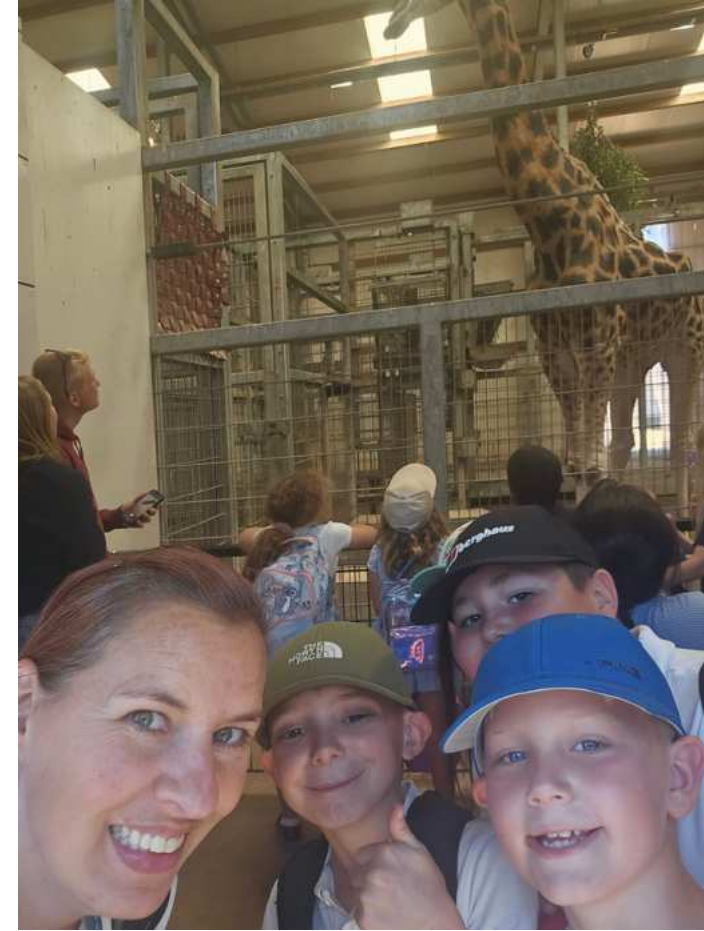
I could not have been prouder of Year 3 on our amazing zoo trip! They behaved wonderfully and smiled ALL day!

# Maths over the Summer!

Maths is everywhere!



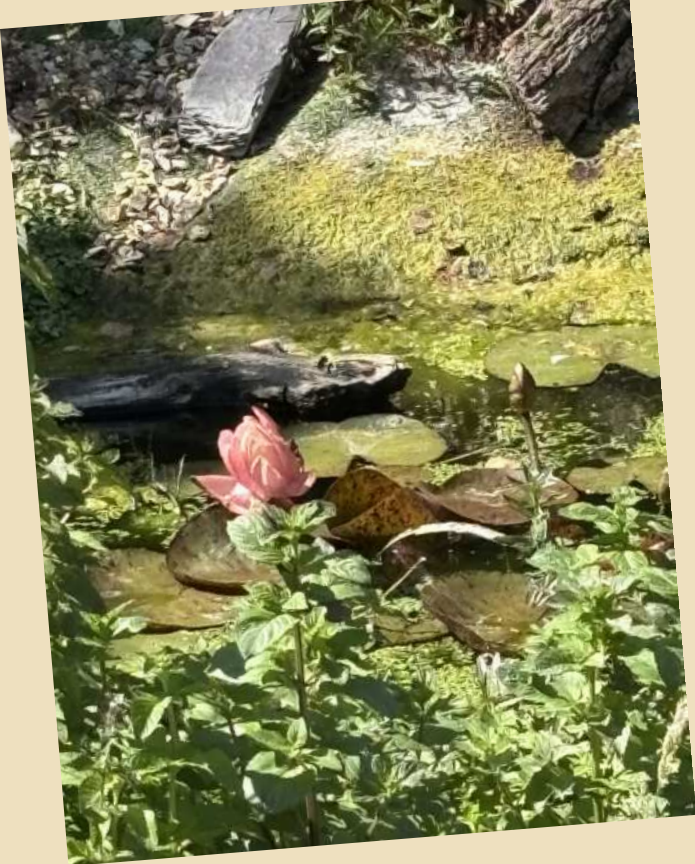
Areas where parents can support children with number over the summer:

- Telling the time
- Using money (counting coins and working out change)
- Cooking - weighing and measuring
- Making estimates of how tall/long something is

On top of this, the summer holiday is a good opportunity to sharpen children's mental maths through addition games (KS1) and times tables games (KS2). This could be by adding or multiplying two cards together or dice together.

Remember they can still use their TTRS account (KS2) or Numbots account (Reception, KS1 and KS2). Numbots story mode is great for developing quick mental fluency.
