Minutes :

- 1. The minutes were accepted as a true record and Havva signed them.
- 2. Matters arising Maddison's AOB will have to carry over to the next meeting as Maddison wasn't at today's meeting.
 - Some children have asked for swings in the jungle gym answer is a definite no on Safety grounds!
 - There are 2 issues with the bike shed.
 - a. The bikes are not put in there properly and sometimes it feels as if there's not enough room.
 - b. Children are messing about in there before the teacher comes on duty. Councillors reported that children have been locked in the bike shed by other children. Councillors said that Miss Adams had spoken to the children in KS2 worship but it's still happening. They also said that a boy in Y5 has been drawing inappropriate pictures on the bike shed wall in the condensation. *Mrs Mills will report this to Miss Adams and Mrs Page.*
 - Football goals the children would like proper goals in the football area so that if the ball hits the post it's obvious. *Mrs Mills will speak to Mr Needham.*
