

Over this term we would like you to choose a **minimum of 6** different activities below as your homework tasks. **Everyone must complete 6 tasks throughout the term.** We hope that by continuing with this style of homework, this will encourage everyone to take part and give parents a chance to become more involved in working with their children on fun, creative and exciting activities. Children's completed homework tasks will be recorded and monitored. **Any children who do not complete at least one homework task per week, either at home or during homework club, will be spoken to and will be asked to stay in at playtimes to complete their tasks.**

Please ask parents, family members or friends to join in and have fun. You can use your homework task book for writing tasks, evidence logs, saving photos taken for evidence. When each task is completed you need to bring it in or take photographs as evidence. (These can be emailed to your teacher). As evidence is seen we will tick off your tasks and record your choices. We are hoping by giving everyone choices that a selection of activities will be completed by pupils with support from family members.

1. History Research Flag Fen. Present your information in a PowerPoint, a model, a fact file or in another interesting way. How much different information can you include?	2. French Design a meal and label all of the different foods in French.	3. English Find a picture of a place that you would like to visit. Write the start of a story that would make the adults want to visit. Be descriptive!	4.Science Use a fridge magnet to test different items. Make a list of the items that are attracted to the magnet. Tell me why you think these items are attracted to a magnet.	5.Maths Complete 15 minutes a day on Times Table Rockstars for a week.	6.DT Make a marble run – you could use the insides of kitchen roll – make sections where the marbles will run faster or slower.
7. English Find some photos of different places. Write some captions to go with these.	8. Maths Make a cake! Write me the recipe showing all the different masses of the ingredients. Extra dojo points for photos of scales!	9. Art Draw and sketch me your favourite animal in its natural habitat. Include as much detail as possible.	10. RE Find or draw three pictures/ symbols that represent each part of the Holy Trinity and explain what the Holy Trinity is.	11.Science Find out how magnets can be used in different ways. List 10 in a fun way. Could it be a list? Or maybe a poster?	12. Maths Write down 10 3-digit numbers. Round them to the nearest ten and the nearest hundred.
13.English Make a poster about some spelling rules you know – ask your parents if they can remember any – make it easy to read/ use for other children.	14. RE Create your own piece of art showing Jesus' baptism. You can use your own chosen technique e.g. pastel, paint, collage, crayon etc...	15. Music Find out about a famous musician. Write a fact file about them, telling me lots of information. Where were they born? What music did they make?	16.PE Explain the changes to your body as you exercise – complete some PE activities and either take photos, draw pictures or write sentences to show what happens.	17. Handwriting Choose 10 challenging words, find the correct spellings and write them out three times each. Show me your best handwriting.	18. Reading Find a short poem – learn it off by heart. Can you also remember the name of the author?
