Homework can be completed in homework books, or photographic evidence can be submitted through the **CLASS DOJO**. **Homework is due in every Tuesday.**

1. R.E. Write a prayer that Christians might say on Good Friday. Remember why Christians believe Jesus died and the sacrifices that were made.	2. Science Dissolving, evaporating and sieving. With your grown up, take some pictures of you sieving, dissolving and evaporating solutions and mixtures at home.	3. Maths – life skill! 12 and 24 hour time Please collect a time booklet from school to practice converting between 12 and 24 hour time.	4. Geography UK knowledge: Find and label 10 rivers on a map of the UK. Pick up a blank sheet in class. Include the river that runs through Wainfleet.	6. R.E. Write as list of at least 5 people who you think were responsible for Jesus' death. You can read the stories of Holy Week (Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday) from a Bible to help you. For extra House Points you could order them from most to least responsible.
7. Geography World knowledge: Find pictures of 7 volcanoes or mountains in the world. Write down which country and continent they are found in and write down one fact.	8. English Complete 20 minutes on Rollama.	9. Geography/DT Make a shoe-box biome. Include animals, foliage and landscapes from that biome. Use google for some ideas. Bring them in for the geography display.	10. ICT Skills / Maths Play on TTRockstars for 10 minutes every night for a week. Take photos or write in your homework book for evidence.	11. Maths Complete the short 'Properties of Shape' test on maths.co.uk to revise last year's shape knowledge. OR create a poster on the properties of different shapes.	12. English/PSHE Dreams and Goals Write a paragraph about your dreams and goals, what would you like to do and be when you are older. Research careers on https://www.firstcareers.co.uk/
13. DT / History Design and make a Viking longship. This can be made from any materials that you have at home, even Lego!	14. Cooking (DT) Plan and make a meal that only requires one method of cooking (E.g. oven, hob or grill). Think about what materials you use to keep yourself safe from the heat.	15. Reading Read with an adult every night for a week. Adults, please ask your children questions as they read to you. Please record this on Reading with Parents.	16. Art Create a piece of artwork using the pointillism technique.	17. Reading Read to someone different or read in an usual location.	18.
