Children's completed homework tasks will be recorded and monitored. **Any children who do not complete at least one homework task per week, either at home or during homework club, will be spoken to and will be asked to stay in at playtimes to complete their tasks.**

(You could set up a portfolio), or send them to me via Microsoft Teams. As evidence is seen, we will tick off your tasks and record your choices. We are hoping by giving everyone a variety of choices, a selection of activities will be completed by pupils with support from family members.

ART/DT Using a shoe box or something similar, create a scene from your favourite book. Bring it in and see if we can guess which book it is from.	Science Find out about where the material wool comes from. What are its properties and what it is used for?	English Research a famous Superhero and write a fact file about them.	MATHS Log onto Numbots or TT Rockstars and practice your 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Can you beat your own time or challenge a friend?
