Ideas were as follows :-

- Lots of flowers (seeds scattered rather than set beds)

- Hedges and fences – a mixture of the two, as hedges would be great for wildlife
- Community Vegetable garden
- Seating, benches
- A covered area or pavilion.
- A fairy garden

Councillors were encouraged to talk to their grown-ups about the area, gather more ideas and bring them to the next meeting.
