It was decided that :-

- children who borrow a book should write their name in a School Book Bank book.
 - Children must look after the books and remember to bring them back and put them neatly on the shelves
 - School councillors will make sure that the shelves are tidy
 - School Councillors will give a short presentation to their class about the school book bank.
 - Children will be able to start borrowing books after half term.
3. **Recycling Area** - the recycling bins were moved away from the School Book Bank - councillors will make posters and print off pictures to create a 'recycling area'.
 4. **Anti-Bullying Group** - we talked about what bullying is. Mrs Mills said that Anti-Bullying week is coming up soon. We decided that the next meeting would be devoted to preparations for anti-bullying week.
